About Us

Barenbrug breed, research and develop UK forage products across the UK and the world. Over 3,000 hectares of UK farmland produces Barenbrug UK grass seed. All Barenbrug UK mixtures are designed to deliver productivity and success for UK farmers.

Making up 65% of utilisable agricultural area, grass is the UK's national crop. Like other crops, grass requires proper management to optimise yields, benefit the environment, and enhance animal health and performance. It takes 17 years on average to release a new variety.

Cropvale

Our dedicated trial site in Worcestershire, over 15 acres, has been testing the performance of Barenbrug UK's forage varieties and mixtures bred for use by UK farmers for over a decade. It is also one of 2 sites in the UK testing for grass diseases for the England and Wales Recommended Grass and Clover List.

Knutsford

Our newly established site in Cheshire is home to our UK-based breeding programme and serves as our primary development research hub. It provides a base for variety testing and trialling seed mixtures and agronomic solutions.

For over 30 years the Barenbrug-AFBI partnership has been extremely successful. Barenbrug UK act as the commercial partner to AFBI, bringing to market the excellent varieties bred in Northern Ireland. We currently have 30 ryegrass varieties listed on the England & Wales Recommended Grass and Clover List 2025/2026, 22 of which were bred by AFBI. In the 2025-2026 Grass & Clover Varieties for Scotland, we have 25 ryegrass varieties listed as first choice, 22 of which were bred by AFBI.
